26	PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the parties	s have reached a settlement resolving all claims in	
27	this action. The settlement is contingent upon the	expiration of the federal agencies' 45-day review

period required by the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. § 1365(c)(2).

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that, in accordance with federal law, no judgment disposing of this action may be entered prior to 45 days following the receipt of the proposed settlement agreement by the United States Department of Justice and the national and Region IX offices of the United States Environmental Protection Agency. See 40 C.F.R. § 135.5 (requiring the parties to provide notice to the court of the 45-day agency review period under 33 U.S.C. § 1365(c)). Such notice is being mailed to the agencies on January 13, 2023. Given approximately 10 days for the mailing and processing of receiving the settlement, the regulatory agencies' review period will end by approximately March 9, 2023. If any of the reviewing agencies object to the proposed Settlement Agreement, the parties would require additional time to meet and confer and attempt to resolve the agencies' concerns. At the end of the 45-day review period, the parties will file either a Request for Entry of the Proposed Consent Decree or a notice that the agencies objected to the Proposed Consent Decree.

In light of the settlement agreement entered into by the parties and the need to await the conclusion of the agencies' 45-day review period, the parties, through their respective counsel, stipulate and agree as follows:

WHEREAS, on August 16, 2022, Plaintiff filed its Complaint initiating this action;
 WHEREAS, the parties successfully completed and executed a Proposed Consent Judgment on January 12, 2023;

WHEREAS, on January 13, 2023, Plaintiff submitted the Proposed Consent Judgment via
